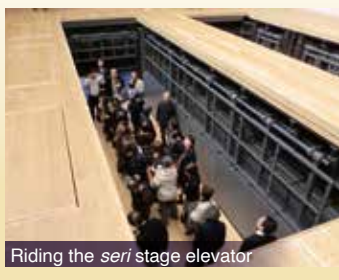

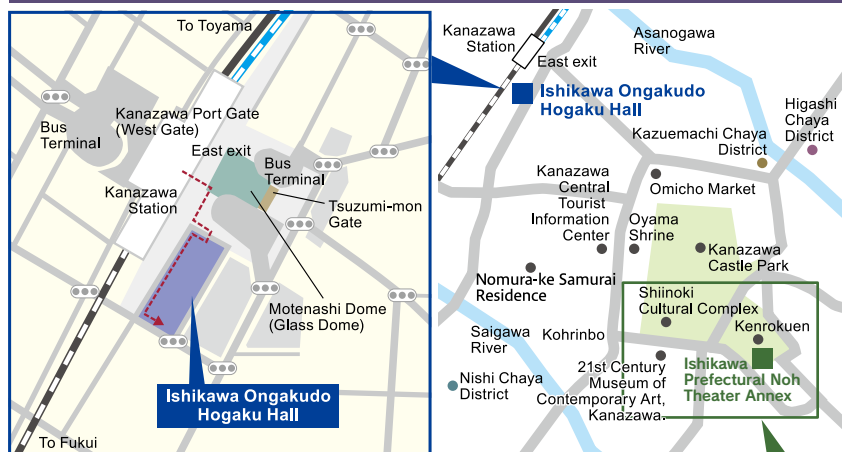

- Take the bus from Kanazawa Sta. Kenrokuen Gate (East Gate) to Hirosaka/21st Century Museum. A 10-minute walk from the bus stop.
- Take the bus from Kanazawa Sta. Kenrokuen Gate (East Gate) to Dewa-machi. A 1-minute walk from the bus stop.
